

# District 105w – Lions Clubs International The Winning Team

## 105W CLUB FELLOWSHIP AWARD – RULES

1. This annual Award is meant to encourage Lions throughout our District to visit and to meet with their fellow Lions from Clubs other than their own and to generally encourage friendship and fellowship throughout the District. The Award is competitive and based upon the previous Visiting Lion Competition.
2. The Award year will start on 1st January and finish on the following 31st December. The Club earning the most points during the year will be awarded a Trophy. The presentation will be made at the District Convention the following year and the trophy retained for a 12 month.
3. Points will be awarded for visits to other Clubs within 105W and attendance at 105W District Meetings. The only exceptions to this are MD or International Conventions, for which one claim only per Lion is allowable.

5. Points will not be awarded for attendance at any meeting by a District Officer or Zone Team member in their Administrative or Official capacity.
6. In any one day, a Lion may only count points for one visit. No points shall be awarded for cancelled meetings.
7. Claims for points shall be made on Claim Forms (which may be photocopied), further supplies of which may be obtained from the District Competitions Officer or downloaded from the Club Members page of the District Website. Claims must be substantiated by the signature of a senior Officer present at the venue of the visit. (eg. Club President or Secretary, Zone Chairman, District Governor, etc).
8. Completed forms must be forwarded to the District Competitions Officer within 14 days of the visit to qualify.
9. The decision of the District Competitions Officer shall be final in all matters concerning adjudication, and that Officer is personally disbarred from the competition even if as a representative of their Club.
