**105W CLUB SCRAPBOOK COMPETITION – RULES**

1. Scrapbook entries to cover the period 1st July and finish on the following 30th June followed by a six month period of collation and completion.
2. The District Competition Officer to be advised of forthcoming entries by 31st December.
3. Scrapbook entries to be brought along to 105w Convention, normally in March. Entries to be judged by an independent panel of three people comprising non-Lion dignitaries/press representatives coordinated by the Competitions Coordinator and the Trophy presented to the winning entry at Convention.
4. Scrapbooks can be of any size as required by local circumstances, similarly for the design of the outer cover.
5. Content should be as far-ranging and interesting as possible given that the scrapbook is a record of the President's year in office and the club activities during that time.  
Items which the judges will expect to see, therefore, include photographs of official and social occasions, fund raising activities, presentations, recipients of donations etc, etc, accompanied by newspaper cuttings, Club Newsletters, Charter Nights and event programmes, tickets, Race Night Programmes etc, etc.
6. Marks will be awarded for:
  - a. Appeal of outer cover and general appearance 10%
  - b. Overall quality and variety of content 50%
  - c. The story line of the content 20%
  - d. Press, radio and TV publicity received and recorded in the scrapbook (including press cuttings) 20%

Total 100%
7. The decision of the judging panel will be final and not open to challenge.
8. In association with all Inter Club Competitions, the Competitions Coordinator will remind Clubs of this initiative early in the Lions year.
9. The winning club shall be eligible to enter the Multiple District competition for the current Lionistic year judged at the MD Convention immediately following the District Convention. It is the responsibility of that club to ensure that their winning scrapbook is received at the MD Sergeant at Arms desk prior to the opening of the Multiple District Convention.
